## Residential Clean-up Guidelines

### **Absolutely No:**

- ❖ Liquids
- ❖ Rock, Concrete or Burned Material, ash, etc.
- ❖ Fluorescent Bulbs, Ballasts
- ❖ Paint (containers must be open and contents dry)
- ❖ Closed containers
- ❖ Household Hazardous waste (i.e. pesticides, cleaning solvents, oil, etc.)
- ❖ Tires
- ❖ Tree stumps / Brush / Lawn Clippings/Leaves
- ❖ Camper Refrigerators
- ❖ Propane Tanks
- ❖ Commercial Appliances
- ❖ Asbestos
- ❖ Railroad ties

### **Extra Charge Items (Payment is due upon pick up):**

- ❖ Mattresses, box springs, couches, chairs, (anything with springs) - \$20.00 each
- ❖ Appliances including washers, dryers, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, humidifiers, stoves, refrigerators & freezers (MUST be EMPTY), water heaters, furnaces, microwaves, air conditioners) (must be loaded near the gate so they can be unloaded easily) - \$45.00 each
- ❖ TVs – \$45.00 minimum charge (Let us know if it's a Console TV)
- ❖ Computers and household copiers \$40.00 (Computer monitors - \$30.00)

### **When disposing of lawnmowers, snow blowers, or motorcycles:**

Please cut off the tires and tubes (the tires are acceptable if cut off) and drain the fluids (oil & gas) and dispose of properly.

DDS is not allowed to dispose of oil and gas.

Bicycles and anything with tires and tubes must have the tires cut off before placing in the dumpster.

*~Containers are rented on a weekly basis, please call when ready for pick up~*

Please Note the Following:

- 1.) Containers must be paid for before pick-up. If a container is not paid for upon pick-up Demcon Disposal reserves the right to dump the container where it stands.
- 2.) When directing our drivers to drive on your driveway or lawn please keep in mind our truck is 30,000 lbs empty. We are not responsible for any damage that may occur.
